25 years ago, AOA fought legislative battles for you that brought OD's medical reimbursements in greater parity with your MD counterparts.



In 2012, COA stopped a State Board of Optometry regulation that would have required all Optometrists to include your full name exactly as written on your license & your license number on all signs, business cards, stationary and any forms of advertising.

In 2012, COA passed legislation to allow ODs to perform certain CLIA waived tests in office.






